NURSING INFORMATICS (NU C204)

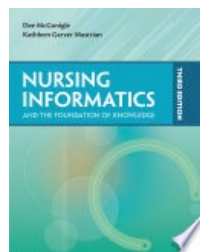

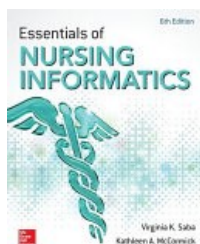
DEFINITION:

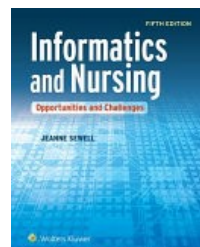
