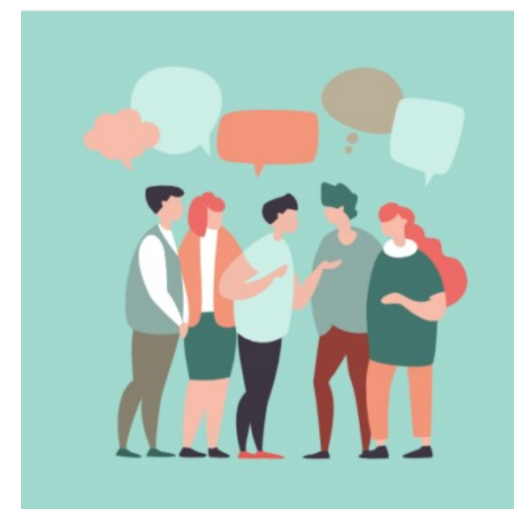

- the psychological study of social behavior, especially of the reciprocal influence of the individual and the group with which the individual interacts.

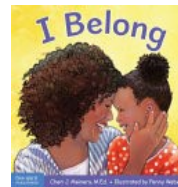

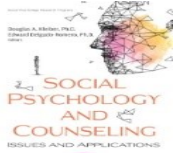

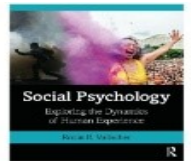
