

MANIFESTATION OF RIZALIAN CORE VALUES AMONG ELEMENTARY STUDENTS AS PERCEIVED BY SELECTED TEACHERS

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This study focused on the manifestation of Rizalian core values specifically, “responsible, considerate and courteous and with integrity” among elementary students of JRU, as perceived by their teachers. Five faculty members from the different grade levels were interviewed in this study. This study aimed to: 1) determine and analyze the manifestations of Rizalian Core Values as perceived by the teachers, and 2) to identify which among the core values must be given emphasis. Areas from the teachers’ involvement of the Rizalian core values to how students cope in the core values were explored in this qualitative study. The significant findings of this study were: 1) most of the pupils manifest the institutional core values; 2) the third core value, “with integrity” is the most manifested core value among the elementary students; and 3) the first core value “responsible” should be given more emphasis.
